ORDER

- 1) Permission to appeal refused.
- 2) No order of application for extension of time to appeal.

REASONS

1. Having read the Claimant's application and supporting documents and the Defendant's reply and supporting documents, I am satisfied that this proposed appeal has no realistic prospect of success.
2. So far as the initial shortfall in satisfying the Judgment is concerned,
 - (a) it would not be a matter for appeal but for enforcement; and
 - (b) the shortfall has been made up.

I add that the Defendant should not have unilaterally made the deduction to account for tax but should have dealt with that issue in its arguments placed before the Judge. That error has been corrected.

3. The Claimant is not entitled to payment of his salary between 1 May 2025 and 12 May 2025 because the Judge found he did not attend work after 1 May – see paragraphs [30] and [31] of the Judgment. That is why the remedy set out in paragraph [32] allows for April's wages.
4. Paragraph [32] therefore also provides for a penalty for the late payment of April's wage. No question of late payment of May's wages arises because they were not due.
5. I have dealt with the merits of the proposed appeal which renders consideration of the application for permission to extend time academic. The Claimant should not assume from this that time would necessarily have been extended.
